Expanding Fish Tracking Array with Real-Time Monitoring of Tagged Sturgeon and Salmonids

The purpose of the project is twofold, to provide upgrades to the existing array of 300 fish detecting monitors, situated in the Sacramento River, Delta, and Suisun, Grizzly, San Pablo, and San Francisco Bays. The upgrade includes replacing older, obsolete monitors in the array and creating a new database using 'Hydra' software. The second part of the project will add real-time capability to the array.
