The Sacramento Deep Water Ship Channel extends approx-43 miles from the western region of the central valley near Collinsville to the Port located in West Sacramento. The Sacramento District is responsible for maintaining the channel to an authorized depth of 30-feet and 33 miles of dual purpose navigation and flood protection levee. County locations are Sacramento, Yolo, & Solano. The channel directly supports a critical Coast Guard station for California Bay Delta and is a vital link to the richest agricultural and industrial regions in the world.
