**San Joaquin River, Port of Stockton**

The Stockton Deep Water Ship Channel extends 41 miles from the Port of Stockton to Antioch, CA. The Sacramento District is responsible for maintaining both the channel to 35-feet and existing bank protection. County locations are Contra Costa, Sacramento and San Joaquin. This port is the largest inland port and the 4th busiest in California. The Port is a vital link to the California's Central Valley's agriculture industry, providing more than 90% of fertilizer used by growers and more than 50% of California's bagged rice to Japan. Strict water quality standards and the presence of endangered species have increased requirements for sampling and handling of dredge material and resulted in shortened dredging windows, creating problems in maintaining channels to authorized depths each year.
