**Dedicated Project Yield**

The purpose of this project is to capture funding associated with the Dedicated Project Yield. The Department of the Interior (Interior) has the responsibility to dedicate and manage annually 800,000 acre-feet of CVP water (b)(2) water for fish, wildlife, and habitat restoration purposes and assist the State of California in its efforts to protect the waters of the San Francisco Bay/Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Estuary. The management of (b)(2) water is being closely coordinated with the management of CALFED's Environmental Water Account (EWA). The program objectives are to: (1) improve habitat conditions for anadromous fish in CVP controlled rivers and streams and the Bay-Delta to help meet the AFRP doubling goals; (2) increase survival of out migrant juvenile anadromous fish, especially in the Bay-Delta; (3) enhance recovery of listed threatened and endangered fish species; and (4) monitor and evaluate to assess the effectiveness of (b)(2) measures.
