**Sacramento River Small Diversion Fish Screens  
(Phase 7)**

The purpose of this project is to construct fish screens at 9 to 15 diversion sites after collecting fish loss data for two diversion seasons at each diversion. Diversion sites to be monitored and screened will be selected by the Anadromous Fish Screen Program based on relevant information including the size and location of the diversion, potential for fish loss monitoring, and the voluntary participation of the diverter. This information will help quantify the benefits of fish screening and will assist in prioritizing which diversions should be screened.
